An election is hereby ordered to be held on May 2, 2026, for the purpose of electing two (2) Directors for four (4) year terms, to end in May, 2030.

The first day to file for a place on the ballot is Wednesday, January 14, 2026, and the last day to file is Friday, February 13, 2026, by 5:00 P. M.

A person may run for election to the District's Board of Directors as a write-in candidate and to do so must file a declaration of write-in candidacy. The declaration must be filed with the Secretary of the District's Board of Directors or his/her designated agent by mail, fax, email or in person. A declaration form may be downloaded/printed from the website of the Texas Secretary of State at https://www.sos.texas.gov/elections/forms/pol-sub/2-23f.pdf.

Deadline to file write in candidacy declaration for **May 2, 2026** general election is by 5:00 p.m. on **Tuesday, February 17, 2026**.

The Election Day polling place is the Mauriceville M. U. D. Office at 15509 FM 1442, Orange, Texas 77632 between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.

The Election Administrator and Presiding Judge for the Election Day polling place is Christy Davis. The Presiding Judge shall appoint an alternate judge and two clerks for the proper conduct of the election at the election polling site.

Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted each weekday at the Mauriceville M. U. D. Office at 15509 FM 1442, Orange, Texas 77632, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. beginning on Monday April 20, 2026, and ending on Tuesday, April 28, 2026.

Additional early voting will be held at the Mauriceville M. U. D. Office at 15509 FM 1442, Orange, Texas 77632 as follows:

Applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than the close of business on April 20, 2026.

The Election Administrator and Presiding Judge for the Election Day and the alternate presiding judge shall be compensated at the rate of \$10.00 dollars per hour and the election clerks shall be compensated at the rate of \$9.00 dollars per hour. The judge or clerk who delivers the election returns may be paid an additional sum of \$25.00 dollars as provided in accordance with the Election Code Section 32.091 and 32.092.

In the event the candidates for office are unopposed and the secretary of the board of directors or his designee receives certification of same required by Section 2.052(b), Election Code, the secretary or his designee shall post notice that the election is not to be held in compliance with Water Code 49.103.
